Archbishop Anthony Fisher said if company bosses revised Business Ethics 101, they might recall businesses were established for particular purposes and to prosecute those purposes within the confines of ethics and the law. "Businesses should not use their commercial power to hold managers, employees, customers and the broader community to ransom on matters unrelated to the purposes of the business," he said. "The CEOs and managers of corporations have additional responsibilities to shareholders to pursue only the proper purposes of the company and to maximise profits within reason." They misused their authority and their corporation's and shareholders' resources when they pursued private social or moral ends... Archbishop Fisher also condemned "marriage equality-friendly" chief executives for pressuring executives of other corporations to join them, and - applying "pink bans" on companies and executives who refused...

**Licence Deed for use of Parish premises by School System.** Under civil law, Archdiocesan Trustees holds title to land of the Archdiocese of Sydney, including land canonically owned by the Parishes of the Archdiocese. Trustee for the Sydney Catholic Schools Trust (SCS) has been established as the new legal entity that will conduct the systemic schools in the Archdiocese, and will now be the 'approved authority' for purposes of civil law and civil regulatory authorities. The Licence Deed is needed because, where previously the Archdiocese Trustees was the 'proprietor' of System Schools for purposes of the NSW Education Act (Act), SCS will now be the 'proprietor' going forward. SCS must demonstrate to the educational authority (NESA) that it has security of tenure over the premises where System Schools are conducted. By letter dated 15 August 2017, the Archbishop confirmed to NESA the intention for the premises where System Schools are located to be licensed to SCS.
