The Apostles' and Athanasian creeds are accepted by some but not all of these churches. Until the early 20th century, it was universally assumed that the Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed was an enlarged version of the Creed of Nicaea, which was promulgated at the Council of Nicaea (325 AD).</p>
