Ignatius, during his ministry, fought two groups of heretics: (1) Judaizers, who did not accept the authority of the New Testament and clung to such Jewish practices as observing the Sabbath, and (2) docetists, who held that Christ had suffered and died only in appearance. Ignatius untiringly affirmed that the New Testament was the fulfillment of the Old Testament and insisted upon the reality of Christ's human nature. Ignatius was an early Christian martyr and an important figure in the early Christian church. He was an "apostolic father", which means he had direct contact with Christ's apostles and, the second or third Christian bishop at Antioch in Syria. Ignatius is best known for a series of letters he wrote during the journey he took from Antioch to Rome, where he became a martyr.</p>		<p>St John Paul II was the head of the Catholic Church from 16th Oct. 1978 until 2nd April 2005. He was born in Poland on 18th May 1920 and died on April 2 2005 at the age of 84. We celebrate his feast day on 22nd October. Pope Saint John Paul II had an enormous devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Most Holy Rosary.
