In the New Testament, we see that five foundations are central to Jesus' life and mission to proclaim the Good News, and our faithful continuation of that mission today must be built upon the rock of His life and mission. Five foundations are essential for building healthy and disciple-making parishes. In the full version of <b>Go Make Disciples</b> available at <a href="http://www.gomakedisciples.org.au">www.gomakedisciples.org.au</a>, we can find a four step process (<b>Reflect, Review, Discern and decide, Act</b>) which our parish or community can undertake to reflect upon the place of each foundation in the life of Jesus and in our community, review how that foundation is being expressed in the actions and priorities of our parish or other community, discern and decide how God might be calling our community to strengthen that foundation, and take action with the help of the support and resources outlined in <b>the Mission Plan</b>. As part of this process, our parish community will be able to consider a list of strategies to strengthen these foundations for mission. Our parish can also enter into this process by attending a Parishes for Mission day, which will be offered regionally and online by the Parish Renewal Team of the Sydney Centre for Evangelisation.</p> |  |
