Total lunar eclipse of the Moon (last Tuesday) might appear in all different shades of orange and red. This dazzling effect is due to light being filtered through the Earth's atmosphere. The other thing is that the light becomes refracted which means it gets bent towards the Moon like a lens. So, it lands on the surface of the Moon and you end up with this red glow.
